FUND MANAGER'S REVIEW

Market Review

The benchmark FBMKLCI closed the month at 1545.13 points (Feb 2011: 1491.25) up 53.88 points.

The ringgit has further strengthened to 3.0253 per USD due to continued positive outlook on the currency and underlying economy.

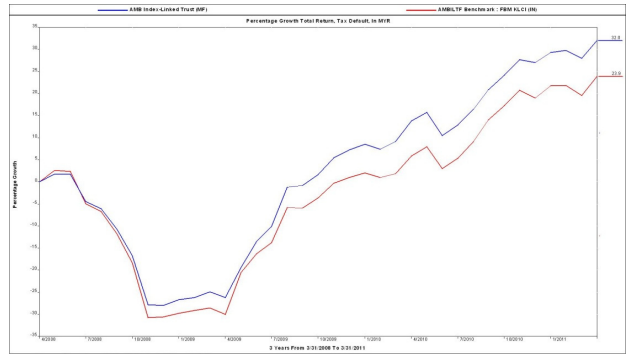
The KLCI index was on a downhill slide in the first two months of the year but rebounded in March despite the negative external factors. The political conflicts in the Middle East and North Africa continued to put sustained pressure on oil price, trading above \$100 per barrel. Meanwhile it was yet to ascertain the impact of the earthquake in Japan to demand and supply equilibrium, such as global supply chain especially in electronics and automotive sectors.

Comments

The fund continues to closely mirror the performance of the benchmark reflected by the high correlation of 99.05% against the benchmark FBMKLCI. Based on the NAV of RM0.8842, the Tracking Error as at 31 March 2011 stands at +1.389%. The Index fund was rebalanced in order to maintain the cash balance according to the monthly cash commitments.

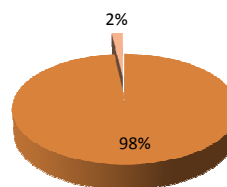
